

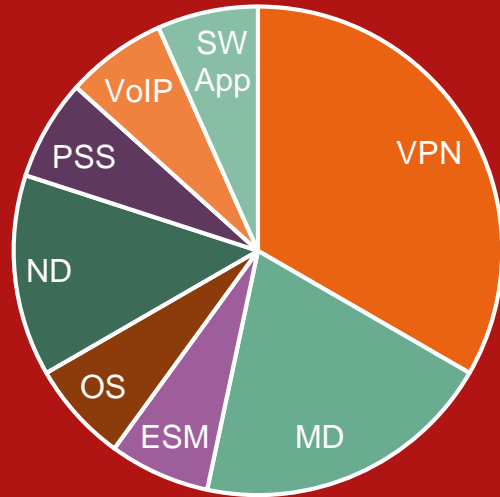

Stakeholder Engagement

- “DHS Study on Mobile Device Security” recommends using NIAP PPs and the NIAP PCL
- A few months following publication of the WIDS EP, DNI ES 2017-00043, “Wireless Technology in the Intelligence Community” cites the NIAP PCL
- CSfC added four NIAP validated products to the CSfC Components List
- Engaged with Navy/Marine community and industry reps at AFCEA West
- Participated in the 2017 ATARC Federal Mobile Computing Summit and Mobile Working Group focused on increasing efficiency and reducing cost via cutting-edge mobile solutions within the USG
- Briefed NIAP to National Defense University Authorization To Operate class enhancing customer knowledge of the value of deploying NIAP validated products
