

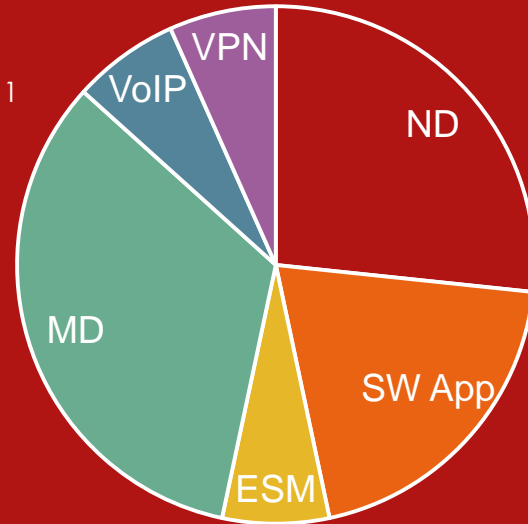
# NIAP 2017 2nd Quarter Progress

## Product Validations

15 evaluations added to the PCL

### Evaluations by Technology

- VPN IPSEC (VPN): 1
- Mobility (MD): 5
- Enterprise Security Management (ESM): 1
- Network Device (ND): 4
- Voice over IP (VoIP): 1
- Software Application (SW App): 3



## Stakeholder Engagement

- Briefed three sessions at the 2017 ICMC held in Arlington, VA 17-19 May 2017 which focused on cryptographic certification and the effect of technology advancements on our current paradigms.
- Attended, briefed, and led a panel discussion at NSA's Information Assurance Symposium held 19-21 June 2017 which focused on cross-community collaboration to address the government's most challenging IA concerns.
- Briefed Department of Homeland Security (DHS) Cyber Security Division on NIAP evaluation processes and Protection Profile (PP) development to discuss DHS use of security requirements in NIAP PPs beyond mobile.
- Held the Spring Validator and CCTL workshop for discussion of issues arising from evaluations as well as updates on crypto guidance and data management tools.
- Participated in the 2017 IA Tech Expo and engaged with over 200 industry attendees. Provided each rep with a summary of the NIAP mission and the process of evaluating commercial products for use in NSS.

## Common Criteria Recognition Arrangement

- **CCDB meeting held in Amsterdam with four significant agreements made:**
  - Exact Conformance (promulgates US evaluation methodology as mandatory among all member nations)
  - Certificate Validity (assigns expiration dates to all evaluations ensuring the most current products are available on the Certified Products List)
  - Voting Procedures drafted (streamlines voting process among all member nations)
  - Supporting Documents procedures (further implements the updated CCRA to ensure approval of collaborative Protection Profiles)
- **Engaged with US representatives to ISO for 15408 (Common Criteria) revision**
